



KASHMIR

In the 18th century, “cachemire” shawls found their way to Europe : handwoven shawls in the very soft and delicate wool from a mountain goat called “Lapra Hircus”. These shawls had dazzling colours and were most elegantly designed. The main theme was the design which we call “paisley” nowadays (or “cachemire” in french : a “comma-shaped” design, which originally represented a stylized flower bud)

Of course the “paisley” design is the main design in the new Omexco collection of printed non-woven wallcoverings.

Printed in black on a background colour in very deep red, sand, olive green, lilac – and printed in white on anthracite, capuccino, cream..., the paisley design whirls through the collection, sometimes combined with matching plain items, sometimes alternated with a multicoloured stripe or a floral design.

The wallcovering is 1 m wide, has a European fire standard (Class B S1 D0), is washable, light resistant (Xeno 6-7), and obtained a marine certificate. It is stable and easy to install (glue on the wall, no need to humidify the backing) and is supplied cut length (no minimum order required). Custom colouring is available upon request.
